

# BACKGROUND

The gallery's relationship with Andrew Salgado began when Christopher and Jaco first met him during their visit to London in 2013, where he currently resides. The gallery was actively looking to bring a figurative artist on board and later in 2014, he had his first official solo in South Africa with Christopher Moller Gallery.

Salgado created this piece, Laughter in the Dark, specifically for the gallery and the subject matter is a homage to his fascination for the complex and convoluted storyline of the book of the same name written by Vladimir Nabokov (most famous for his later novel Lolita). His ability to narrate through complex artistic exploration and symbolism is extraordinary and this is truly a standout piece we are thrilled to be showcasing – this is a piece that takes time to unpack: much like the novel it emulates, there are plot twists and turns to ponder and reflect on.

## BIOGRAPHY

ANDREW SALGADO (b. 1982, Canada) holds an MA in Fine Art from Chelsea College of Art (2009), and is widely regarded as one of the leading figurative painters of his generation. He has exhibited worldwide, with solo exhibitions including London, New York, Tokyo, Miami, Toronto, Cape Town, Sydney, and throughout Europe.

In 2017, Salgado was the youngest artist ever to receive a survey exhibition at The Canadian High Commission in London. He has received extensive press both online and in print, and he frequently donates to charities and is a frequent advocate for LGBT causes. His works have successfully entered the secondary market with prices frequently doubling their estimates, including a piece at Phillips New York selling for five times its estimate in June 2021.

His works have been collected extensively, including The Oketa Collection, The Royal Bank of Canada Collection, The Masahiro Maki Collection, Government of Canada, The Jordanian Royal Family, Simmons & Simmons, the Esquinazi Collection, Edwin Oostmeier Collection, and more.

He lives and works in London, England.

- Kindly note all ZAR prices are excluding 15% SA VAT.
- Kindly note, shipping cost excludes any destination taxes & import charges

### CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS ACCEPTED.

Our bank (Nedbank) has given us the option to do the credit card transaction via e-payment solution for credit cards. This is a secure product that enables the Gallery to send you a link with the amount pre-populated. It requires you to complete your credit card details. This protects you, in that you don't have to give out your credit card details to a third party, while you complete it online. Unfortunately, this system does not accept American Express or Diners Club credit cards.

Please inform your bank of the transaction in advance and provide them with our Merchant code: 2738375 should your bank reject the request from a foreign country.

Please click on the link and complete the transaction by completing your credit card details. Kindly note each link has an expiry date and is valid for 2 days.
